THE COLLEGE

In today's world, high academic achievement is very important. Many people in Pakistan are dissatisfied with the standard of the undergraduate education available to them and would prefer a more rigorous British-type curriculum. The University College of Islamabad aims to provide an educational programme which combines the best that can be offered: academic guidance from the University of London, a range of subjects and individual attention.

The College has at present capacity of 140 students and offers tuition for a range of courses which lead to Diploma in Economics and Degrees of the University of London. In April 1999 the College was given permission to teach Diploma in Economics of the University of London. The Lead College for the BSc Degrees is the London School of Economics (LSE). These courses are taken over in three years and are taught by experienced subject specialists who are qualified from Pakistan, UK and USA.

BSc (HONS) DEGREE COURSES

Tuition is available for the following University of London International Honours Degree Programmes:

- **BSc Accounting & Finance,**
- **BSc Business and Management,**
- **BSc Economics, BSc Economics and Finance, BSc Economics and Management,**
- **BSc Management with Law/Law with Management, BSc International Relations**

STRUCTURE OF BSc COURSES

- The minimum period of study for the BSc degree is three academic years. Degrees have a flexible structure.
- Each degree consists of a number of units which are classified as either Foundation, Intermediate or Advanced. Some units are compulsory; this ensures that essential elements are covered by all students.
- Students are required to make a serious attempt at the examination for a total of 12 units, including a minimum of four foundation units and all compulsory units.
- Progression through each degree is guided by prerequisites which govern Intermediate and Advanced units.

TEACHING PROGRAMME

International students enrolled with the College are required to study four courses in each of the three academic years. Teaching runs from Monday through Saturday, and students are required to attend lectures, tutorials and/or seminars. Each subject is taught for a minimum of three hours per week.

EXAMINATIONS AND DEGREES

Examinations are held in Islamabad. These are administered by the British Council and the scripts are marked in the UK. Degrees are awarded by the University of London .

FACILITIES

The College has a well-stocked library with a wide range of essential texts and books. Journals are also available, such as the Economist, Time and many others. A Local Area Network (LAN) of twenty seven-workstation is available for the students. Students can have access to internet facility.

STUDENT SOCIETY

The College has a Student Society which arranges excursions and many interesting student activities.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR BSc HONOURS DEGREE COURSES

1. A student normally should be aged 17 or above by the 30th November in the year of registration AND Passes in two subjects at GCE 'A' level with grades A-E and not less than Grade C in at least three further non overlapping subjects at GCSE or GCE 'O' level.

OR

Passes in three subjects at GCE 'A' level with grades EED and not less than Grade C in at least one further subject at GCSE or GCE 'O' level.

OR

BA or BSc Upper second division, or American High School Diploma with Two AP's at Grade 3, 4 or 5. The Special Admissions Panel of the University of London will consider these qualifications on an individual basis and its decision would be final.

AND

Proof of competence in English as prescribed by the University of London, in its Prospectus (EMFSS 2017-18)

AND

Mathematics with no less than Grade C at 'O'-level or equivalent.

The college will apply for your initial application to the University of London. The deadline to send applications to London is September 20, 2017.

Examination fee for four subjects
