THE COLLEGE

In today's world, high academic achievement is very important. However, many people in Pakistan are dissatisfied with the standard of the undergraduate education available to them and they would prefer a more rigorous British-type curriculum. The University College of Islamabad aims to provide this facility by offering a wide range of subjects taught in small classes which allow individual attention.

The College has at present, capacity of about 200 students and offers a range of courses which lead to degrees from the international programmes of the University of London. These courses are taken over in three years and are taught by experienced teachers who are qualified from the UK.

CERTIFICATE OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN COMMON LAW

In August 2009, the University College of Islamabad has been given permission to teach the Diploma in Law of University of London after an inspection visit of the representative of the University of London. This Diploma is intended to provide an opportunity to reach first-year of LLB, to students that do not satisfy the normal entrance requirements for LLB but can demonstrate that they have the ability, motivation and maturity to study at this level. **After completion of the Diploma students will receive a certificate and can join second year of the LLB (Hons) Degree.** The Diploma is accepted by many UK Universities and students can be considered for entry to the second year of their

respective Laws Programme. **In 2015, UOL has changed the name of the diploma, now it is called "Certificate of Higher Education in Common Law."**

EXAMINATIONS AND DEGREES

Examinations are administered by the British Council in Islamabad. All scripts are marked in the UK and the Degrees are awarded by the University of London.

THE FACULTY OF TEACHERS

The College engages lawyers with British degrees to teach the courses.

FACILITIES

The college has a library with more than 1,500 textbooks of Law. It orders every year the latest books required to support the courses. It is subscribed to the New Law Journal. A Local Area Network (LAN) is available for the students and can have access to internet facility and the Virtual Learning Environment.

AND

LLB

Law is central to society. Every community has found a need to regulate the rights and duties of individuals both to each other and the State. A law degree will certainly lead to a detailed knowledge of law and the legal system, but it is also an opportunity to develop powers of analysis and reasoning. The raw material of legal studies is human activity in all its diverse forms, that is why such a wide range of topics is covered. Not only is this variety an important foundation for those intending to practice law, but it is also a great advantage to students wishing to pursue careers in government, commerce, or in any managerial or administrative field.

LLB students do not require any foundation course and can complete Bar-at-Law or LLM in one year. UCI also helps its students in seeking admission and scholarships for higher studies in UK, Europe, Canada and USA.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR CertHE Common Law

1. Passed at least two 'A' level subjects OR FA/FSc/ICS with 60% OR any other secondary qualification acceptable to UCI.

AND

2. Prove the proficiency in English Language by IELTS, O Levels and/or UCI's English entry test.

AND

3. A candidate should be aged 18 years of age on or before 31 October in the year of registration.

4. Pass in the Diploma in law admission test and interview as prescribed by the University of London Laws consortium.

HOW TO APPLY

Please contact our office for the English entry test and an interview to assess your academic aptitude. Only those candidates will be admitted who qualify both the entry test and the interview. Bring along copies of your previous secondary qualifications. The deadline to apply is August 31, 2017.
